### Thanks and Gratitude to Philip R. Simpson for 50 Years of Service



Philip Simpson has been a foundational part of what makes Owen Funeral Home special today. He was originally a Lawrenceburg, Kentucky native. He graduated the Kentucky School of Mortuary Science in 1967. He then joined our staff as a young lad of 19. He began his career at our original location on 2611 Virginia Avenue. He remembers his early days getting adjusted to living in the upstairs apartment of the Virginia Avenue location. "It was unsettling at first; sleeping in a funeral home," he said. He started by sleeping fully dressed with the lights on. He recalls one night waking up to a loud noise and a rolling sound. He pulled the covers up and didn't move. In the morning he went up in the attic and saw that a bag of marbles had spilled over. Eventually he became at ease with living in a funeral home and began what would be 50 years of service to others.

After serving his two year apprenticeship, he became a licensed funeral director and embalmer in 1970. In 1987, he also earned his Life Insurance License from the state of Kentucky. For 50 years, Philip has worked alongside the Owen family as they strived to serve the community with "Sincere Service." His father advised him to "always treat families as you would one of your own." Philip stayed true to these wise words through the years. You could not find a more professional, kind, and caring funeral director.

As time has gone on, we have had to say goodbye to Bird and Edith Owen and others who first opened the doors to Owen Funeral Home. Philip worked alongside all of these special directors and has carried forward what he learned from them. He has helped train a new generation of caring and skilled funeral directors. It is with a warm heart we thank Philip Simpson for the past 50 years!

Pineapple Delight Cake



Mix: 1 box yellow cake mix  
1 cup oil  
4 eggs

Stir in 1 cup pecan pieces and 1 small can mandarin oranges (partially drained).

Put in 3 round cake pans and bake at 350 for 30-35 minutes, allow to cool completely.

Icing: 16 oz. can crushed pineapple  
16 oz. carton Cool Whip  
2 small boxes Instant French Vanilla Pudding

Combine pineapple, cool whip and instant French vanilla pudding.

After icing cake store in refrigerator.
