CAT CRACKERS BY ERICA SKAGGS

A quick and easy last-minute snack (especially if you're hosting!)

Here's what you'll need:

- 11 oz. mini-Clubhouse crackers
- 1/2 cup Avocado oil
- 2 tbsp Ranch-dip seasoning blend
- 1 tbsp Crushed red pepper flakes
- 1/2 tsp Garlic powder
- 1/4 tsp dried or fresh dill
- 1/8 tsp Cayenne pepper
- Parchment paper
- Large non-stick sheet pan
- Large freezer bag (for combining ingredients)

Directions:

- 1. Whisk the oil, Ranch-dip seasoning blend, red pepper flakes, garlic powder, dill and cayenne pepper ingredients together.
- 2. Once combined, pour your mini-Clubhouse crackers into a large sealing freezer bag with your mixture of oil and spices. Shake 'em up a bit so the mixture gets dispersed evenly on each cracker
- 3. While all these ingredients marinate, preheat your oven to 250 degrees
- 4. Scatter your mini-Clubhouse crackers across a pan lined with parchment paper and cook for
