



## Albert "Bum" Steiger III

July 29, 1946 - March 6, 2020

On Friday, March 6, 2020, Albert "Bum" Steiger III, loving husband and father of four, went home to his Heavenly Father at the age of 73. Bum was born on July 29, 1946 in Louisville, KY to Albert Steiger Jr and Edna Mae Weiser. He was raised in the West End with his 11 siblings and is a graduate of Saint Benedict Grade School and Flaget High School in 1964. He served in the United States Coast Guard for 6 years as an Electricians Mate, 3rd Class on the USCG Cutter-Chilula. After his Military Service, he became an insurance salesman for Prudential Insurance for 25 years. He married the love of his life, Pamela M. Steiger, on November 29, 1985. Bum had a passion for his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ and was a proud member of Saint Peter the Apostle Catholic Parish; where he was a leader in biblical studies and loved lecturing at mass. He gave countless hours of service to the Catholic Church, Louisville Archdioceses and Southwest Community Ministries. His beloved wife and dogs (Zack, Smilie and Mylee) loved to fish, boat and camp at Rough River Lake - Axtel Campground. He was an avid reader and loved classical music and politics. He is best known for his overwhelming kindness, infectious smile, compassionate spirit, wit and "Bumily Jokes." The family would like to extend our deepest and most sincere gratitude to all the Surgeons, Doctors, Nurses, Hospitars and other caregivers who have provided the most excellent care and professionalism for our hero.

Bum is preceded in death by his father, Al, his mother, Edna, his brother Joe Steiger, and his sisters Kathy Steiger and Betty Clark. He is survived by his

wife, Pam, his four children Michael Steiger, Amy Steiger, Travis Scharrer and Justin Scharrer (Sherry); and nine grandchildren: Josh Weilage, Zack Steiger, Alexa Hand, Gavin Scharrer, Tyler Weilage, Tatum Scharrer, Elijah Steiger, Trent Scharrer and Logan Scharrer. He also is survived by his brothers: Gary Steiger, Dave Steiger and Kenny Steiger; and sisters: Jean Steiger, Jan Kuntz, Karen Berry and Sue Spink. He has several cousins, nieces and nephews.

His funeral Mass will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday March 10 2020 at St. Peter the Apostle, 5431 Johnstown Rd. with burial to follow in Calvary Cemetery. 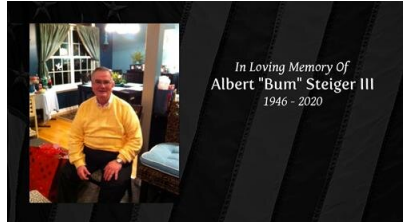
