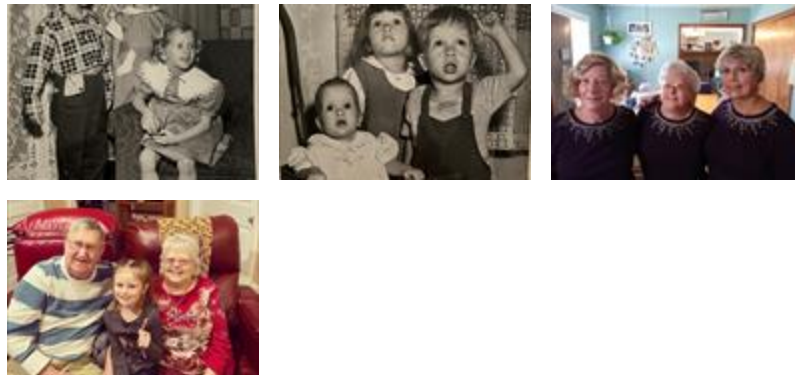

I wanted to post a recipe for sticky buns I got from Aunt Ann for all to enjoy. She would make this for breakfast when the family got together for a week at the beach. I loved it so much that it was my request for breakfast the morning of my wedding day. I remembered the recipe this past fall and when I made it my sons recently said where was this all their lives.

Ann's Easy Sticky Buns

1 bag of Frozen yeast rolls (can cut in half after just 5 min out of freezer, but we usually didn't)

1 (3.5 ounce) package of butterscotch pudding and pie filling (not instant)

3/4 cup brown sugar

1 teaspoon cinnamon

1/2 stick of butter melted

Night before:

Spray 9x13 glass dish or Bundt pan with canola oil. Spread out frozen rolls in prepared pan. Optional: sprinkle layer of chunked pecans and or raisins

Blend 1 (3.5 ounce) package of butterscotch pudding and pie filling (not instant), 3/4 cup brown sugar, and 1 teaspoon of cinnamon in a small bowl. Sprinkle over the rolls. Then drizzle melted butter over top. Lightly cover (we use plastic wrap that is sprayed with canola oil). Let sit over night or 8 hrs.

In morning, remove cover and bake at 350 for 25-35 min. Within 5 min of removing from oven invert onto a plate and lift away pan. Serve warm.
