



## Beulah (Chappell) Hoskins Rogers

Beulah Hoskins Rogers, peacefully passed away on September 12, 2024, surrounded in love. Born in Baker Fork, KY, Beulah earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Kentucky Wesleyan University of Owensboro. She went on to receive her Masters from Western Kentucky University and Rank One Certificate from the University of Louisville. She retired from teaching after 30 years of teaching in three different counties. Beulah was a long-time member of Broadway Baptist Church and was a senior and active member of The Hunting Creek Country Club and its Nine Holes group where she even made a hole in one as a younger member. She hosted many occasions of the Wine and Wenches group.
