



Bobby Eugene Bohler

March 4, 1935 - June 3, 2019

Bohler, Bobby Eugene, 84, of Louisville, KY passed away Monday, June 3, 2019.

He is preceded in death by his father, Ernest Everet Bohler, his mother, Mildred Alice Bohler and his sister, Lois Yvonne Glover.

Bobby is survived by his loving wife of 59 years, Adeline Render Bohler; two daughters, April Brown (Kenny) and Allison Bohler; three grandchildren; Emma Brown (Lee), Elle Brown and Beau Brown; and his sister, Wanda Lobred.

Bobby graduated from Valley High School in 1954. He served 2 years in the military, stationed in Germany, with the 4th Armored Div., 15 Cav. He worked as Truck Master Spec. 4 Acting Jack as Sgt. He worked for Equifax for 21 years and then worked for Precision Automation in sales for 17 years.

Bobby spent over 30 years with the Pleasure Ridge Park Fire Department, starting as Fireman 1st class, then later as Safety Director and a member of the Board of Trustees. He was President of the Kentucky Firefighters Association in 1969, and was inducted into the KFA's Hall of Fame in 2018.

Bobby was a member of Beechland Baptist Church for 72 years. For the past

five years, he worked with the Kentucky Harvest Program thru Beechland, giving left over food from 13 Jefferson County Schools to needy people.

Bobby was a member of the Valley Masonic Lodge 511 for 53 years. He was an Honorable Kentucky Colonel and a member of the National Wild Turkey Federation. He loved to hunt and was a fantastic artist. He also loved the Kentucky Wildcats and UK Basketball.

His funeral service will be at noon on Monday, June 10, 2019 at Owen Funeral Home, 5317 Dixie Hwy with burial to follow in Kentucky Veterans Cemetery Central-Radcliff. Visitation will be from 1-6 p.m. Sunday at Owen Funeral Home.
