



## Cecil Morton Taylor

December 20, 1939 - November 24, 2022

Cecil Morton Taylor, 82, passed away Thursday November 24, 2022.

He was born in Leitchfield, KY on December 20, 1939, to his parents Verna and Anita

(Hayse) Taylor. He moved with his family to Louisville as a young boy and would later attend DuPont Manual High School where he graduated in 1957. He joined the Air Force in 1960 and lived in Germany for a time before returning to Louisville, getting married and working at the Courier Journal. He would change career paths and become a union electrician, working for several different contractors until eventually getting hired by Ford Motor Company where he worked as a maintenance electrician at the Kentucky Truck Plant until he retired in 2005. He was a member of the IBEW Local 369, UAW Local 862 and a longtime UK basketball fan.

He is survived by his children Mark Taylor (Lynne), Elizabeth Montgomery (Bob) and Angela Bradshaw (Gary); grandchildren: Lana, Daniel, Tabitha, Emma, Katie, Britley, Cody, Maggie, Sai, Bryan and Abby; Sister Dixie Miller and Goddaughter Ashley Queen (Barry) and her three children: Noah, Brayden and Tanner.
