He passed quietly, but unexpectedly, near Somerset Kentucky at his home and the residence of his Family Home Provider and Caregivers. Charlie was a very social individual. He loved being around people, laughing and teasing. He was always ready to greet you with a smile and a hug...usually a great big exuberant hug. He hugged like he was never going to let you go. He rarely arrived anywhere without calling out "Hi" ...again with great exuberance...before he fully crossed the threshold to enter the building. Charlie had certain things he always wanted in his possession such as photos, keys, cokes, money, and mementos of places he'd been or people he'd seen. The more he could carry in his pockets, the better. And babies, how he loved babies.

Charlie was born in Louisville to parents Charles L Bishop Jr and Mattie Jane (Garner) Bishop.

He was preceded in death by both his parents and his brother-in-law, Randall W Guest.

Charlie is survived by his LaGrange Family: Denise (Bishop) Guest and AiJax (AJ) Guest. He is survived by his Somerset Family: Devin and Jazma Staley (Hunter, Ellis, and Dakotah), Cecil and Tammy Powers, and Corey Staley. Other survivors include his Maternal Aunt, JoAnn Young, and his Paternal
