June 5, 1930 - April 21, 2023

Charles E. Price (Charlie) was called home peacefully in his sleep on April 21, 2023. Born in Shelbyville, Ky on June 5, 1930, he graduated from Shelbyville High School in 1949. In 1950, he married Barbara Derksen and shortly thereafter entered the US Air Force. He served during the Korean War as a Radio Mechanic in the Strategic Bomber Squadron both in the states and overseas servicing B-29 and B-47 bombers. While stationed in Lake Charles, Louisiana, he had two children (Becky and Keith), and moved to Louisville in 1955 after being honorably discharged. Shortly after returning to civilian life, he was employed by DuPont LeMours, where he served in the maintenance department until he retired after 27 years with the company. He was a Stuart High School Booster member and, as a hobby, was a skilled wood craftsman. Charles was preceded in death by his wife of 69 years (Barbara), daughter (Becky), brother (Bill), and sister (Nancy). He is survived by his son (Keith) and daughter-in-law (Angie), six grandchildren (Matthew Price, Mallory Olenick, Jason Meeks, Bryant Call, Clarissa Farris and Elizabeth Hartman), eight great-grandchildren and son-in-law (Don Call).
