Connie (née Langley) Rohleder of Louisville, Ky passed away at the age of 64 years old. She was a beloved member of the Louisville Church of Christ, a dedicated alumna of the Beta Gamma chapter of Chi Omega fraternity, and a committed wife and mother. She cared for children at the pediatric office she worked at for more than 25 years, shot film photography throughout her life, and volunteered with her children's schools in their youth.
