



Douglas Ray Kinslow

November 14, 1932 - December 17, 2023

Douglas Ray Kinslow, 91, of Louisville, Kentucky left this world on December 17, 2023. A wonderful father, brother, and uncle. Doug was respected, loved, and cherished by his family. Born on November 14, 1932, to Hubert and Lillie Kinslow, he was predeceased by his parents and sister Wanda Mae Mitchell. There will be a visitation held on Wednesday, December 20, 2023, from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM at Owen Funeral Home, 5317 Dixie Hwy., Louisville, Kentucky. The burial will be at 2:00 PM, at Louisville Memorial Gardens West.

A decorated veteran, Doug served as a Hospital Corpsman (HM3) in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War. His four years of active military service (1951-1955) were divided between service on board, Balboa Naval Hospital in San Diego, CA, and then on to Korea where he served with the Marine Expeditionary Force at Camp Pohang.

After returning from the Korean War, Doug started his career as a pro boxer. Fighting in the middleweight division, Doug had 39 pro fights, going 36-3. By the end of the 1950's he transitioned his career, becoming a professional wrestler appearing on cards in more than 20 different states and Canada. Madison Square Garden was the highlight of his 20-year career.

After becoming a father, Doug began scaling back his traveling lifestyle, working in Louisville with a contracting and property management company. He later retired from the company as a vice president. Doug is survived by his son, Hubert Scott Kinslow, and many nephews, nieces, great-nephews and great nieces.
