Earl Tigland Arnett, Jr. was born on November 3, 1945 in Paintsville, KY to Ivola Hale Arnett and Earl T. Arnett, D.D.S. He grew up in Owingsville and Mt. Sterling.

Earl graduated from Mt. Sterling High School, Class of 1964, and attended Eastern Kentucky University.

In his youth, Earl was a Boy Scout and later became a Boy Scoutmaster with a High Adventure Troop in Mt. Sterling. They hiked several portions of the Appalachian Trail. A big highlight of their years was their trip to Philmont, New Mexico. Earl was active in the Mt. Sterling Jaycees.

Earl was a credit manager and his career moved the family in 1982 to Boca Raton, and later Jacksonville, FL. He was a member of the First Baptist Church, Jacksonville, FL.

Earl was a member of Barnett Lodge, York Rite, Morocco Shrine in Jacksonville. He was bestowed the honor of Knights Commander Court of Honor with the Scottish Rite in October, 1999.

In Louisville, he was a member of Sunset Lodge, Kosair Shrine and the Oriental Band, where he entertained people in parades by being Genie. He loved being Genie and it showed. He participated with the Band in competitions at conventions and has nine trophies for his performances.

Earl is survived by his wife of 52 years, Donna Denney Arnett, and his son, Earl T. Arnett III and Chloe, their English Setter. He will be dearly missed.
