Glen enjoyed a very active lifestyle until Macular Degeneration took his eyesight. When retired we were residents of the Glades Country Club in Naples, Florida. (1989-2016) This afforded us the opportunity to play golf and meet many new friends. On his 75th birthday, he walked 15 miles, and on his 80th birthday, he walked 16 miles!
