“ I have so many great memories of Janice, most especially when we were little. Some years we (including my mother, father, 2 sisters and myself) would spend Thanksgiving together and other years Christmas or Easter . We celebrated these holidays with Janice, Julie, Jennie, aunt Mildred and uncle Robert at Granny and Peepaw's house in Owensboro. I remember all 6 of us kids, Jennie, Julie, Janice, Angel, myself, and Elizabeth playing together upstairs at Granny and Peepaws. We had the most adorable child-size mexican painted chairs, one for each of us! We would line them up in a row and pretend to play school with the big blackboard and chalk to write our "lessons" on! I remember several christmases that we also spent together at Granny and peepaw's. One year we all got sock monkeys and we held them proudly displayed while we had our picture taken. I remember thinking how cool it was that my aunt had three daughters each one fairly close in age to each one of us. I remember Thanksgivings we shared together at Granny and Peepaws and the smell of Granny's cooking was so sweet! And when we got a little too "rowdy "in our play upstairs, some adult would inevitably yell upstairs " settle down!", concerned that we would cause additional cracks in the plaster of the dining room ceiling that was directly below the upstairs where we played. I remember spending Easter together at Granny and Peepaws house and my mom and Aunt Mildred excitedly telling us that the EasterBunny was coming to visit. I remember hearing the doorbell ring and all of us running to the door , opening it as fast as we could so we could "see" the Easter Bunny. By the time we got the door open, the Easter Bunny had "hopped away" but left us six easter baskets filled with lots of goodies! Lastly, I remember that during each visit the Breckenridges made to Owensboro, Uncle Robert would take all 6 of us to the Baskin Robbins store to get us one scoop of any flavor we wanted, either on a cone or in a cup. As we got older, I remember how proud I was of Janice to hear that she had accomplished so much and had become a nurse practitioner! To Dennis, Dillon, Amanda, Aunt Mildred, Jennie and family, Julie and family, I'm so sorry for your loss and am sending you my

deepest sympathy and prayers. She gifted us with her light and we are all better for it. God Bless you all.
