Kathryn Mattingly Clark, 91, passed away peacefully on Thursday morning, July 16, 2015 at the home of her daughter in Jessamine County, Kentucky. She attended Breckinridge County High School then moved to Louisville, Kentucky where she worked for Reynolds Aluminum in support of the World War II war effort.
