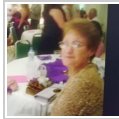

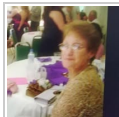

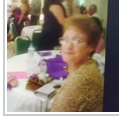
Sandra's yes he is and they together are rewiring the light up there to make it brighter for when we get there.
