Due to the pandemic all services will be private to adhere to the governor's ruling on public gatherings. A celebration of life will be held at a later date.

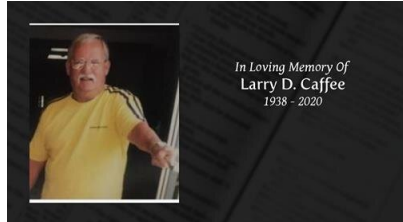
