Linda Owen Miller, 80, passed away Tuesday, September 13, 2022.

Linda grew up in Audubon Park and graduated from Dupont Manual High School. She was later inducted into DuPont Manual's Hall of Fame. She received a Bachelor of Music and Voice Pedagogy from the University of Louisville. She was a former organist and choir director at Aldersgate United Methodist Church, Audubon Baptist Church, and director of the flag corps with Doss High School Marching Band.

A female pioneer in the funeral service industry, Linda became a licensed funeral director in 1986. She lived her life's passion following in the footsteps of her parents, Edith and Bird S. Owen, Jr., founding owners of Owen Funeral Home. She served as past president of Owen Funeral Home and Highlands Funeral Home.

Linda was awarded "Women of the Year" by Women in Funeral Service in 2000 and received Today's "Savvy Sister Award" in 2003.

Following the death of three babies during pregnancy, Linda created Our Little Angel Company, providing register books, preemie caskets, and infant burial clothing.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Edith (Roberts), and Bird Owen, Jr.; husband, Charles Miller; grandmother, Anna G. Roberts, and three infants. She is survived by her brother, David L. Owen (Pam); step-grandchildren, Marcy Doolin, Dan Lee, and Rosa Lee; step-great-grandchildren, Christina Lee, Jarrod Priddy (Caitlin), Ryan Lee, Jordan Lee, and Ben, Julianna, and

Bella Lee; Charles' daughters, Charlene Moderwell, Becky Cales, Peggy Flinn, and Barbara Hjelmstad; 4 great-great-grandchildren; niece, Rachel Barr (Rick), and special friend, Donna Roach.
