Madaline "Louise" Merideth, 85, was welcomed into the open and loving arms of Jesus on February 18, 2024.

She also taught kindergarten and worked as a teacher assistant at a public high school. In most recent years, one of her favorite activities was spending time with her husband and their numerous friends at the peddlers mall.
