Mae Louise Bate Pavey, age 90, passed away November 24, 2018, at Liberty Village, Clinton, IL.

Mrs. Pavey was born on May 25, 1928 to George L. and Rebecca Stone Bate in Greensburg, IN, and grew up on the family farm outside Greensburg. She and Marvin J. Pavey married on November 30, 1950 and resided in Louisville, KY, until moving to Lexington, KY in 2001. She was a member of the Wellman Memorial Wesleyan Church (Louisville) and First Wesleyan Church (Lexington).

Prior to marrying, Mrs. Pavey traveled with her sisters as the Bate Sisters, as song evangelists.
