With profound sadness, we announce the passing of our devoted mamaw, mother, and friend Mary “Red” Winifred Daley. She passed away surrounded by her loved ones on February 5, 2022 at 7:15 pm.

Born in Hyden, Kentucky, Mary graduated from Leslie County High School, where she was the assistant editor of her yearbook, played two sports (basketball and softball), sang in the glee club, performed on the folk dance team, and was named the Basketball Queen of 1949-50. After high school, she attended Spencerian Business School in Louisville. In Louisville, she met and married her husband, James R Daley.

Mary retired from the Clorox Corporation in 1994. Mary was, in essence, a caregiver. She took care of everyone she loved, notably her disabled brother and father in his later years. 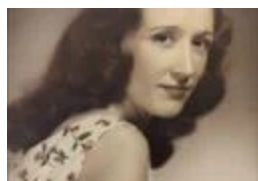
