Nadine (Breedden) Huber, 92, passed away February 7, 2023.

Always a Kentucky girl, she moved to Atlanta to be with her children in 2017

but would tell anyone who would listen that she was from Kentucky and did not like Georgia (or her daughter's cat Sammie!). She loved to play cards, read books and work puzzles and have everyone over for meals (her favorite). She was a beautiful person, both inside and out, who was loyal, honest and empathetic. If you were lucky enough to be loved by her, your life would be changed forever.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Joseph Lee Huber, brother Randall Breeden and sister Doris Neal and her husband Bill and her brother in law Ralph Huber and his wife Betty.
