Phillip Kevin Landgrave (60) of Crestwood, Ky passed away on February 27, 2021 at Norton Brownsboro Hospital. He fought a good fight battling a brain aneurysm but ultimately went home to be with Jesus.

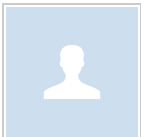
