Robert Richardson, 96, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, November 4, 2021.

He was born to the late Everett and Bertha Richardson on November 3, 1925, the youngest of three children.

He graduated from Valley High School in 1944 where he was the editor of the yearbook.

He attended Pepperdine in California for two years and returned to Kentucky where he received his bachelor's degree from Western Kentucky University. After graduation he returned to Valley High where he taught English until he became the on-screen teacher for TV English.

He received his Master of Education Degree from UofL and became the administrator for Channel 15.

Bob traveled extensively in the US, Canada, and Europe. He was inducted into the Valley High School Hall of Fame in 2015.

His love of teaching never ended, and he taught Sunday School at South Louisville and Ralph Ave Churches of Christ. He was a member of Highland Park Christian Church.

He is survived by his niece, Barbara Chandler (Texas), his great-nephew, Brent Edward Clem (California), and his great-niece, Michelle Eavehart (Texas).
