



Stuart Thomas "TOM" Oursler

December 15, 1937 - January 13, 2021

Stuart Thomas "Tom" Oursler, 83, joined his heavenly family on Wednesday, January 13, 2021. A lifelong Louisville native, Tom was the son of Stuart William Oursler & Carolyn Maureen Quinn. Preceding him in death was Barbara (Reigel) Oursler, his wife of 44 years.

A 1955 graduate of DuPont Manual High School, Tom served in the US Army for 2 years, where he received training that began a lifelong career in telecommunications with Bell South, South Central Bell & AT&T; following his 33-year service retirement in 1989, he formed his own business, continuing this service to many of his loyal customers.

After residing in PRP for nearly 40 years, where their children were raised and the family served as active members of the former St. Clement Church, they built a new home in Stone Lakes in Jeffersontown. Due to declining health from vascular dementia, Tom became a resident of Traditions at Hunter Station, Sellersburg, IN in November 2019.

Tom is survived by his children: Debbie (Tom) Eberle, Denise Oursler, Jeff (Cathie), and Kevin; 7 grandchildren: Keaton, Lauren (Cody), Devin (Kristin), Chad (Naomi), Christa (Cory), Brittany, & Ashley (Nick) & 5 great-grandchildren, and 1 great-great grandchild. Tom also leaves behind family in Somerset, KY: a brother, David, and his nephew, Derek, & 2 nieces – Amy & Beth, and great-nieces & nephews.

In addition, Tom leaves behind his companion, supporter, and longtime friend, Barbara Houston, & together they shared many happy memories over the

past 15 years.

Tom's funeral service will be at 3:00 p.m. Sunday, January 17, 2021 at Owen Funeral Home, 5317 Dixie Highway, with entombment at Evergreen Cemetery.
