Vernon leaves to cherish his memory his wife, Mildred Dennison Harris; daughters, Sandy Blain (Terry) of Falls of Rough, Marty McQueen (Randy), of Shady Valley, TN; son, Mike Harris (Angela) of Marietta, GA; three grandchildren, Ryan McQueen, Elena and Jay Harris; and brothers, Leon and Arthur Harris. Also surviving is “Granny” Alice Dennison, his mother-in-law who lives with them. His service will be 10 am Monday at Auburndale Church of Christ, 5756 New Cut Road.
