On the morning of October 20, 2024, Bill Woods joined the Rock 'n' Roll Community in Heaven.

Bill was born on October 18, 1946, to Marvin and Jessie Woods. He grew up in Jeffersonville, IN and at a very early age found his greatest passion, Music. He often lamented the fact that he couldn't carry a tune and was no more than an average player. But seeing concerts, going to dances, buying records and playing in garage bands made him come alive.

When he met his wife Brenda, music continued to be a central part of their lives. In 1983 they wrote and published "Louisville's Own," which has become the go-to reference for local music. Brenda would go on to work at Triangle Talent and the two of them worked behind the scenes producing shows and working to promote local music. Bill became an unofficial member of The Wulfe Bros and The Monarchs. He spent hours thinking of ideas that would help those bands reach a broader audience. Bill and Brenda traveled to concerts and shows anywhere anytime there was an opportunity.

If there was a greater passion than music for Bill, it was his family and friends who became family. Bill and Brenda were blessed beyond measure with a son, Wayne. Growing up around music and bands, Wayne feels that many have become "aunts and uncles."

Bill always said his real job was computer programming for Rohm and Haas. He developed a love for computers and did websites for Wulfe Bros, Monarchs, Exile, Bobby Vee and Fabian (both icons from the '50s and '60s) and others. Bill was also an Army veteran of the Vietnam Era.

Bill leaves behind his loving wife of 58 years, Brenda. Also, his son and daughter-in-law, Wayne and Leslie, granddaughters Ashley Browning (Adam), Hailey Roark (Adam) and Sydney Woods. Great grandchildren Nolan and Margot Browning and Eli Roark.
