William J. Simpson (“Bill”), age 91, of Louisville, Kentucky, passed away peacefully on May 17, 2026, at Jewish Hospital in Louisville.

Born on February 12, 1935, in Louisville, Kentucky, Bill attended Male High School and spent much of his life building a respected career in the food distribution and sales industry. During the 1960’s and 1970s, he worked as a food sales representative for Clarer of Kentucky, also known as Southern Star, and later for Marhoefer Packing in Jeffersonville, Indiana. In the 1980s, Bill founded Derbytown Distributors, Inc., a wholesale food distribution company that he managed through the mid-1990s. He later returned to food sales with Salem Foods, which became Troyer Foods, where he continued working until his retirement in 2023.

Bill was a hardworking and devoted family man whose commitment to providing for those he loved was evident throughout his life. At times, he worked as many as three jobs to support his family, always

putting their needs ahead of his own. Alongside his beloved wife, Charlotte, he raised five children and built a home rooted in faith, perseverance, and love.

A devout Christian, Bill was a member of St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church and lived his life guided by faith and service to others. He was a devoted grandfather who found tremendous joy in spending time with his family and cherished the special bond he shared with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren. He also loved the game of golf and enjoyed the friendships and fellowship it brought him over the years.

Bill was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 50 years, Charlotte Marie Simpson; his daughter, Michelle Karen Kurk; and his son, David M. Simpson.
